### STRUCTURAL ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Southwest Chapter of the Structural Engineers Association of Washington (SEAW) is offering a \$2000 scholarship to college or university students studying Structural Engineering and who plan to make their professional career in the practice of Structural Engineering, and attend university or have other ties to the Southwest Chapter region of Washington State, specifically in Pierce, Thurston and South King Counties.

#### Requirements of Students applying for the Southwest SEAW Scholarship:

- 1. United States citizen and an official resident of the State of Washington. In addition, a current or former resident of Southwest Washington region as described above.
- 2. At the time of application, be currently enrolled in a program of study majoring in Structural Engineering as an undergraduate in their junior or senior year of study, or as a graduate student.
- 3. Having a commitment to making a professional career in the practice of Structural Engineering.

#### How to Apply:

- 1. Complete the attached application form and return to the SEAW office at the address above.
- Arrange for the colleges and universities attended to send directly to SEAW at the above address a transcript showing courses taken and grades received. If your school uses an electronic transcript system, transcript links should be sent to apflueger@ahbl.com
- Arrange for completion and return to SEAW of scholarship recommendation forms by two
  professors. Please see forms to be filled out below and returned to SW SEAW at the above
  address.
- 4. Complete and attach to your application a personal essay of about 500 words on one of the following subjects:
  - a Your favorite structural course
  - b A significant structural accomplishment
  - c What is better in design- steel or concrete? Why?
- 5. All documents must be submitted to SEAW by **February 28** to be considered for the scholarship.

#### How the Scholarship Winner will be Selected:

From qualified students submitting applications, the Southwest Chapter SEAW selection committee will determine the scholarship award. Final decisions relating to all matters of eligibility and award of the scholarship rests solely with the Southwest Chapter SEAW selection committee. **Scholarship winners will be announced in April.**
